

Services for students in the Non-Public Schools

Special Education services are accessible to eligible, resident students attending nonpublic schools by dual enrollment in the public and nonpublic school systems. Parents of a nonpublic school student who suspect their child may be disabled and in need of special education services may request a Multidisciplinary Team Evaluation of their child to determine the child's eligibility and need for special education services. This parental request may be submitted in writing to the nonpublic school system. The nonpublic school may then contact the Commodore Perry School District, Special Education Contact, Mr. Shawn Algoe, at 724-253-2025, Ext 231, to provide the evaluation.
